Guidance Notes:

It is the responsibility of the DC to acquaint the relevant Companions with these facts:-

It is not obligatory to propose ALL five Toasts. The first two on the list only, may be given but if more than the first two are given then all five on the list must be given

If there are other Toasts e.g. MEZ, Officers, Visitors, etc. they must be preceded by the first five.

Announcing Toasts [by DC and the Proposer] Commence, as at Grand Chapter, with
"Companions..." NOT "Officers of Supreme Grand Chapter, Officers of etc., etc."

BUT in the presence of a Ruler or Representative Commence toasts with

ME Grand Superintendent and Companions, or Deputy Grand Superintendent and Companions, or
Second Provincial Grand Principal and Companions, or Third Provincial Grand Principal and Companions,
or, Representative of the ME Grand Superintendent and Companions [as appropriate]

Proposing Toasts Toast 1 "Companions, I submit..." Others "Companions, I give you..."

Except when there is to be a response when the form is "Companions I propose ..."

Toast 5 The toast to the Officers of Provincial Grand Chapter should be enhanced by a welcome and
short reference to the presence of the Ruler or Representative

Note : It is not correct to print at toast number 4 or 5 that the Grand Superintendent, the Deputy
GSupt, the 2ProvGPrin, or the 3ProvGPrin will respond. Since Rulers "demand admission" they
can decide themselves whether they respond.
